You are invited to join the International Association for Statistics Education (IASE) which is devoted to the development and improvement of statistics education on a world-wide basis.

### ***Foundation and Objectives***

IASE is the education section of the International Statistical Institute (ISI), but may also be joined independently by those who wish participate in IASE's activities, or simply to support the work on improving statistics education and extending its outreach

The objectives of the IASE are:

- to promote the understanding and advancement of statistics education and related subjects;
- to foster the development of effective and efficient educational services through international contacts among individuals and organisations, including statistics educators and educational institutions.

### ***Membership and Executive***

IASE membership is open to all individuals and organisations with a professional interest in any aspect of statistics education including:

- Teaching statistics at a primary or secondary school;
- Teaching statistics in a college, technical institute, university, or in continuing education;
- Teaching, or developing software for statistics computing;
- Teaching statistics, including quality improvement methods, in business or industry;
- Training statistics staff for government statistics offices;
- Developing statistics textbooks, audio-visual materials, or curricula.

### ***Membership dues***

Members pay a basic fee, which entitles them to the benefits of belonging to an international community of statistics educators. This includes the ISI Newsletter and the IASE Review. The usual annual fee is 38 Euros or 19 Euros for members of developing countries. Members may also subscribe to the International Statistical Review (ISR) (which includes Short Book Reviews) at discounted prices. Furthermore, they may subscribe at reduced rates to certain statistics education journals, for example Teaching Statistics (which includes IASE Matters), and may purchase IASE and ISI education publications, including the proceedings from international conferences on teaching statistics, at discounted prices. Members also benefit from reduced registration fees for regular conferences such as ISI meetings, ICOTS and other IASE/ISI organised meetings.

Members from developing countries receive a discount of approximately 50% on the normal membership fees.
