



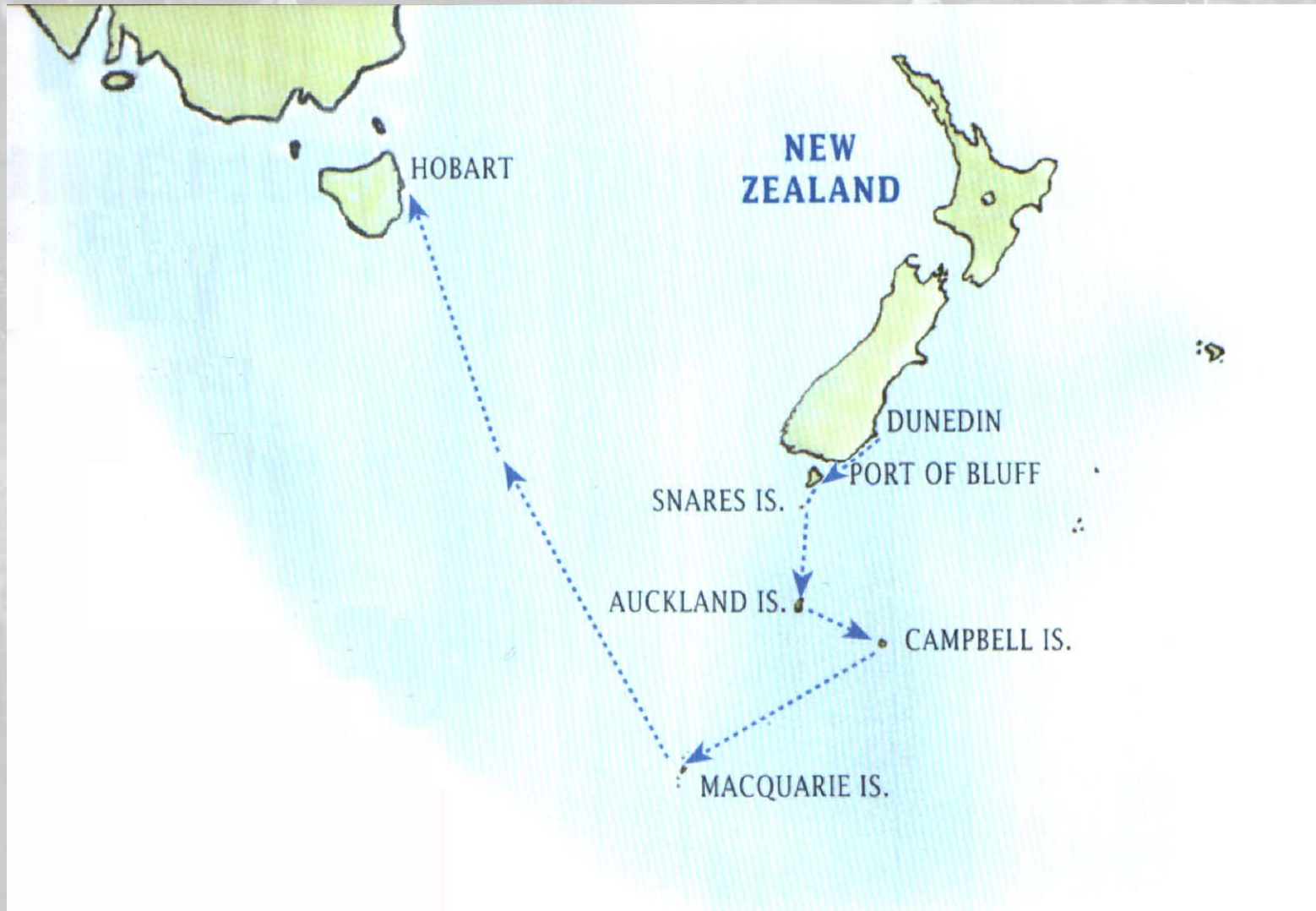

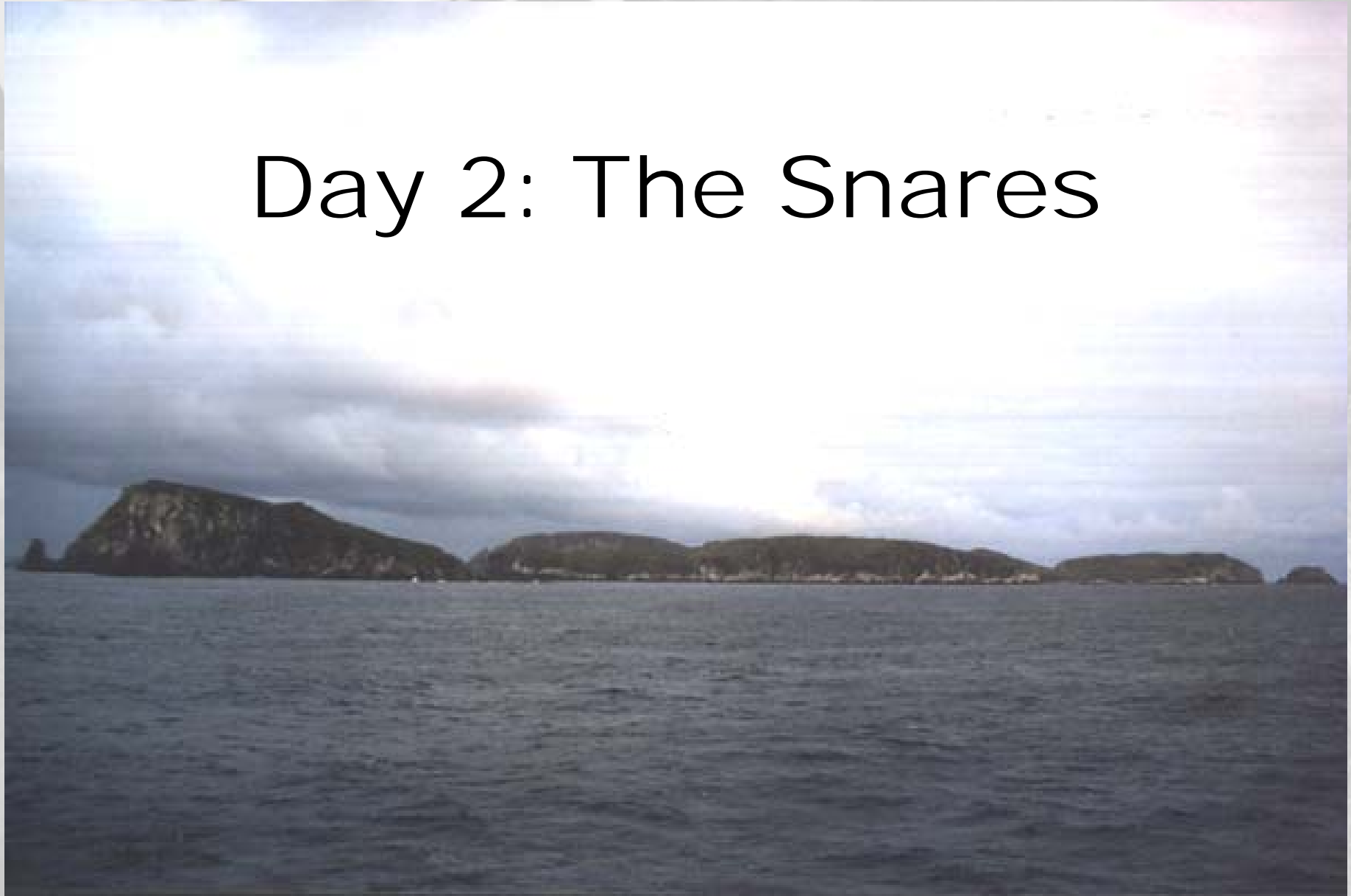

50 x 26 km



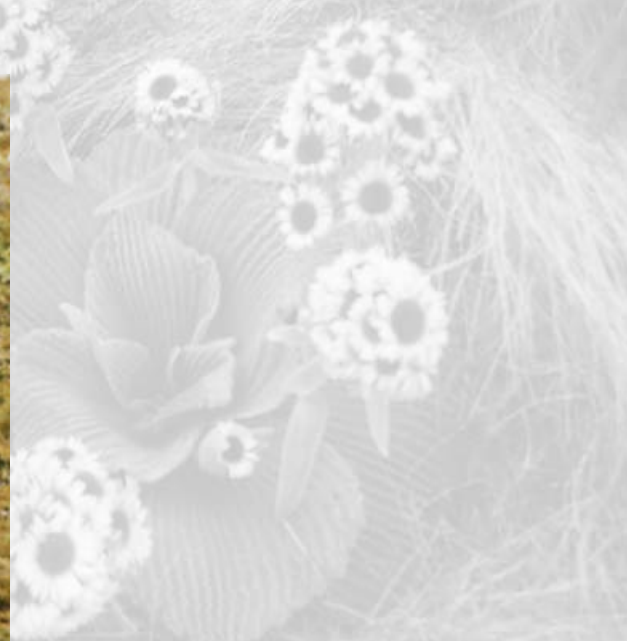
Fauna
