### Abstract

New Zealand Police administrative boundaries go out to the 12NM limit and are made up of 12 Police Districts which are divided into Areas. Each Police Area is divided into several scene Stations. Police Scene Station boundaries are used to record events, and against which statistics are gathered. Police boundaries are based on the 2018 Census generalised meshblock pattern. NOTE: Chatham Islands Station is not included in this dataset, but is part of Wellington District and Wellington Area. Available formats: ESRI shape file (.shp) to 12Nm limit.

Police boundaries are based on the Statistics New Zealand Census meshblock pattern and the MB2018 generalised pattern is the basis for the current definition. A major review of Police boundaries was carried out in 2001, with additional minor changes being undertaken on an infrequent basis to meet changing operational needs. Waikato/Central District boundaries changed on 03 May 2018. Central/Eastern District boundaries changed on 02 May 2019. Waitemata/Northland District boundaries changed 08 August 2019. All Police District boundaries were rebuilt using the 2018 Census generalised meshblock pattern on 29 April 2021, the date of the last change to a District boundary or name.
